#### **Top Readers Lunch**


The top 3 students in each grade level will get to go on a special field trip to Mellow Mushroom where they will create their own pizza and celebrate being a top reader!



## **AR Incentives**

Our AR incentives are designed to be a challenge for students to go above and beyond what is already expected of them on the classroom level in AR. Students in 2nd Grade and up are expected to meet their goals, read in their Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD) and maintain an 85% or better comprehension average. Students in 1st Grade are expected to meet their goals, read in their Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD) and maintain an 80% or better comprehension average. What students do beyond that is definitely challenging and worthy of a reward.



### **Point Clubs**

- The following are the point clubs that will be
- awarded:
- 25pts 200pts 400pts 600pts 800pts 1000pts+
- 50pts 250 pts 450pts 650pts 850pts
- 100pts 300pts 500pts 700pts 900pts
- 150pts 350pts 550pts 750pts 950pts
- Students will awarded for the highest point club they reach. Beginning readers in K-1<sup>st</sup> grade are eligible for the 25 point club. All K-6th grade stu-
- dents are eligible for 50 1,000 point clubs. A reading medal will be give for the 25 point club
- and a trophy will be given for the 50-1,000 point
- club. The more points a student earns the bigger the trophy will be.
